SPECIAL PROJECTS

- MDS assisted more than 194 Pennsylvania farmers impacted by drought through the purchase, donation, and transport of more than 12,000 tons of silage, hay, and corn..
- MDS in the U.S. continued partnering with Mennonite Central Committee and Everence to create a COVID-19 Congregational Relief Fund, which ultimately provided grants of up to \$5,000 each to 216 congregations to support their needs as a result of COVID-19.
- Created in response to the pandemic in spring 2020, the MDS Canada Spirit of MDS Fund provided a total of 81 grants worth \$206,900 CDN/\$161,500 U.S. until spring, 2021. The funds were used to help congregations and other organizations respond to needs in their communities due to the disaster of COVID-19.
