FRESNO AREA GUIDED TOUR OPTIONS

Thursday, Feb 22

TOUR #1MDS Kingsburg Warehouse and Downtown Shops

Come visit the new MDS warehouse followed by a leisurely go-at-your-own pace trip to downtown Kingsburg to visit local shops, eat ice cream and have lunch.

Cost: Free. But bring money for shopping and food. Departs from Butler Church at 9am.

TOUR #2

MDS Kingsburg Warehouse, Huebert Citrus Packing, General Grant Sequoia Tree

Grab a pre-made bagged lunch and visit the new MDS Kingsburg warehouse, Huebert Farms – a large citrus packing facility, and head over to see the famous General Grant Tree, the largest giant sequoia in Kings Canyon National Park estimated to be over 1,600 years old measuring 267 feet tall and 29 feet wide.

Cost: \$50 per person. Departs from Butler Church at 11am.

TOUR #3Blossom Trail

Every spring, orchards outside Fresno burst into bloom. The blossoms are the beginnings of the apricot, nectarine, peach, plum, almond, and citrus crops that will feed California and beyond. But first, they decorate the countryside with a blizzard of petals. This tour will mainly be sitting in a bus observing the blossoms with one stop at Samonian Farms fruit stand and gift shop.

Cost: \$35 per person. Departs from Butler Church at 12pm.

TOUR #4

Leyendekker Dairy Farms, MDS Kingsburg Warehouse

Come and explore a dairy farm that milks 9k cows per day. Along with dairy, they have a stable of Friesian horses imported from Holland. Anyone who has interest in draft horses and wagons will find this tour exciting. The tour will end with a visit to the new MDS warehouse in Kingsburg.

Cost: \$35 per person. Departs from Butler Church at 12pm.
